

## Request for Tuition Exemption/Waiver

Select Exemption/Waiver and provide appropriate documentation

- Ad Valorem/Out-of-District Students (35A) XAV:** Allows students/families to pay in-district tuition if they pay Cooke County property taxes. **Documentation:** Current year Cooke County Deed or Tax Statement. **SAP:** Exempt.
- Border States (43A) XBS:** Waives out-of-state tuition for Oklahoma residents. Waiver needs applied prior to or at the time of enrollment. **Documentation:** Copy of valid Government issued ID with Oklahoma address. **SAP:** Financial Aid GPA only.
- Competitive Academic Scholarship (50A) XUA:** Waives out-of-state tuition for students who qualify for a competitive scholarship of at least \$1,000 during the semester covered by the competitive scholarship, not to exceed a 12-month period. **Documentation:** Notification from Athletic Department or Scholarship Committee and sign selective service statement of registration status. **SAP:** Exempt.
- College Teachers, Professors, Dependents of Higher Education (42) XHE:** A waiver of nonresident tuition to teachers/professors and dependents employed at least half-time by any Texas public college or university. Waiver is effective for as long as faculty remains employed. **Documentation:** Submit a statement from the director of personnel certifying employment of self, parent or spouse as a teacher/professor at a Texas public college/university prior to time of enrollment. **SAP:** Exempt.
- Good Neighbor Scholarship (16) XGN:** Provide tuition assistance to students from nations of the Western Hemisphere. **Documentation:** Be recommended for the exemption by a participating institution and be selected by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. **SAP:** Financial Aid GPA and Excessive Hours applies.
- Military in Texas (39A) XTM:** Allows In-state tuition to military member, spouse and/or dependent children who are newly assigned to duty in Texas; or who previously lived in Texas during assignment to duty elsewhere, or to spouse or child who continuously resides in Texas and/or remains continuously enrolled in higher education in Texas; or dependents who move to Texas 60 days after the service member date of death. **Documentation:** Proof of current or previous assignment to duty in Texas. **SAP:** Exempt.
- Military Intention to stay in Texas (41A) XIT:** Allows in-state tuition to veteran, spouse, dependent or survivors who move to Texas and are eligible for Veterans Educational Benefits; Spouse and/or dependent of non-Texas military member who file an Intent to Establish Residency in Texas. **Documentation:** Proof of Veteran Educational Benefits, Military ID (front and back), signed letter of Intent to Establish Residence in Texas. **SAP:** Exempt.
- NATO Members and Families (56) XNA:** Tuition exemption for nonimmigrant aliens and their dependents who reside in Texas in accordance with the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty. Eligibility for a waiver must be established prior to or at the time of enrollment. **Documentation:** Proof of family being stationed in Texas with NATO forces. **SAP:** Exempt.
- Preceptors and Children (29) XPC:** A partial tuition exemption to Clinical Preceptors and/or their children. May receive \$500 or actual tuition charges, whichever is less, for up to 10 semesters or until a bachelor's degree is earned. Summer terms of less than nine weeks count as ½ a regular semester. Dual credit students not eligible. **Documentation:** Preceptor Exemption Application **SAP:** Financial Aid GPA and Excessive Hours applies. \*Dual credit not eligible
- Teaching/Research Assistant (49) XTA:** Permits resident tuition rate for research or teaching assistants employed at least half time by a public institution of higher education and their dependents. **Documentation:** Submit a letter of employment from the director of personnel, prior to the time of enrollment. **SAP:** Exempt.
