

2024-2025 NCTC Financial Aid Parent Refusal Letter

The U.S. Department of Education gives schools the authority to offer financial assistance when there is clear indication that a student's parents have ended <u>ALL</u> financial support and <u>REFUSED</u> to complete and sign a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). A school may only offer such students an unsubsidized student loan and only after one parent completes and signs this Parent Refusal Letter.

This <u>Parent Refusal Letter</u> waives the requirement for parent information on your current FAFSA application. This letter does not constitute you as independent according to FAFSA standards. In addition, the NCTC Financial Aid Office is only authorized to award your account a Direct Unsubsidized Student Loan subject to the limits for dependent students. <u>NO</u> other federal, state, or college need-based aid will be available, including the Federal Direct Parent PLUS Loan.
